The Facts on Human Rights Violation in Shan State

- Mong Kung has 2000 IDPs, and Hsipaw and Kyaukme have nearly 3000.
- More than 20 infants under 6 months, including pregnant mothers Supplementary food and diapers are needed at the IDP camps.
- A total of 39 people were arbitrarily arrested, including a woman.
- A total of 10 people were injured by landmines and artillery shells fired during fighting between armed groups.
- Six people were killed due to the no rule of law impact by powerful people.
- During this month a total 9 cases of gender based violence incident , mostly they are sexual violence by powerful people.
- There are four robbery cases have occurred in this month.
